

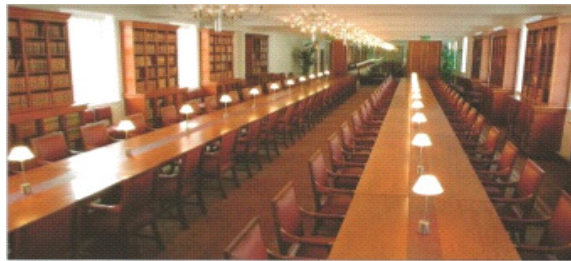
A Bar of Northern Ireland Charity Event
